

Burdens related to Europe (week of 20 January 2019)

1) Brexit

Please pray for the Lord to rule over the UK's withdrawal from the EU. In particular, pray that the saints from other parts of Europe will still be able to come to the UK for trainings and conferences.

2) FTTA Gospel Trips to Europe (24 Jan – 7 Feb)

139 trainees and serving saints from the Full-time Training in Anaheim will be joining gospel trips to 17 European countries. Please pray that:

- The trainees and serving ones from the FTTA will be blended with the local saints
- Many people will be saved and brought into the church
- Every trainee will receive a burden to pray for, give to, or migrate for the Lord's move in Europe.

3) Nordic-Baltic blending conference in Tallin, Estonia (25-27 January)

4) The Lord's move in Germany

Please continue to pray for:

- The visit of FTTA trainees to Germany, who are assigned to Berlin/Leipzig, Hamburg/Bremen, Düsseldorf/Aachen, Frankfurt/Saarbrücken, Stuttgart, and Munich (see point 2 above)
- The gaining of university students on the campuses by shepherding them into the church life and guarding them against all opposition and negative speaking from the enemy
- The provision of long-term visas that would enable the saints to remain in Germany
- A stand-alone house for meetings near the university campus in Bielefeld with adequate space for all functions, and the saints from the adjacent cities to come together in one accord for the testimony in Bielefeld
- An adequate meeting hall for the church in Berlin in the best location, at an affordable price, and readily accessible to public transportation

7) Radio broadcasts in the UK and Spain, continuing distribution of the Recovery Version and ministry publications in the European languages, and shepherding of seeking ones.

8) The raising up of the Lord's testimony in major cities in Europe, including Lisbon, Portugal; Vienna, Austria; Sofia, Bulgaria; Thessaloniki, Greece; Zagreb, Croatia; Belgrade and Novi Sad, Serbia; Geneva and Zurich, Switzerland; Bilbao, Spain; Amsterdam and Rotterdam, the Netherlands; and Tirana, Albania.
