Report on the 2019 European Young People's Conference

Dear Brothers,

The 25th European Young Peoples' Conference took place in Poland from 28th July - 3rd August, 2019.

We thank the Lord for His blessing on this conference through the years, and believe this year the Lord took another step in the preparation of a generation of those who seek His face for His return (Psa. 24).

This was the largest conference in Continental Europe with over 1,500 attendees, more than doubling the attendance five years ago. This growth has mostly been from the expansion of the conference to accommodate parents and children. In addition to the two conferences for junior and senior young people, there are now additional simultaneous conferences for parents and children.

The subject of the conference for the young people was the Lord's Return. We were helped to realise that the time of the Lord's return is short and these are the days to give heed to prophetic word and seek the Lord as the morning star.

While the young people were enlightened with their need to be prepared, the parents were equally impressed with their responsibility before the Lord to raise up our children in coordination with the church so that there may be many "Timothys" produced at home and perfected by the church.
