

# FTTND



The Full-time Training in New Delhi (FTTND) began formally in August of 2010. Prior to that, there were many informal trainings throughout the years since 1997. Out of 46 trainees who passed through the informal trainings prior to 2010, 21 of them are currently serving full-time.

In 2010, the first batch of the formal training began with 24 trainees. Over the years the Lord has faithfully increased the number of trainees. 171 trainees have passed through the training and 45 of them are serving full-time at present. Another 256 trainees have gone through the short-term training.

Currently we have 48 trainees (23 brothers and 25 sisters). The classes are conducted from Mondays to Fridays every week with the goal to help the trainees to get into the central lane of God's economy by arriving at the high peak of the divine revelation and by living out the life of the corporate God-men. During the weekends the trainees are divided into 7 teams to go to campuses and communities in New Delhi and Gurgaon, and they are endeavoring to carry out the practice of the God-ordained way for the building up of the Body of Christ!



# LITERATURE

Soon after Brother Lee shared concerning the need to have 20 high peak literature centers over the globe (India being one of them), Indian Gospel Book Room was established in 1996. It is commonly known today as Amana Literature.

India is a multi-language country composed of 22 official languages. Since the time the book room was established, numerous booklets and title books of the ministry, Rhema book sets, Holy Word for Morning Revival (HWMR), hymnals, and Life-study messages have been translated into various major Indian languages. Currently the Recovery Version of the New Testament is being translated into 6 Indian languages and will be made available to the churches according to the schedule by the beginning of 2021. Translators of the Recovery Version in Hindi, which is the largest spoken language in India, are also being prepared.

Many churches in India were raised up through the spreading of the ministry. For example, an older couple after reading the ministry had left their group and begun to practice the church life. They thought they were the only ones on earth practicing the church life according to the ministry. When they found out and later met the brothers in the church life for the first time, they were in tears of joy!

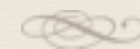
Wherever the ministry goes, we can testify that the people are wide open to the ministry of Brother Nee and Brother Lee. May the word of God continue to run and be glorified in India!



# BRIEF PRESENTATION OF THE LORD'S MOVE IN INDIA



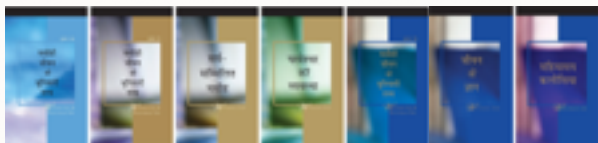

# RHEMA DISTRIBUTION

Rhema in India was formed and began its labor in 2003. Over the past 16 years, millions of pieces of ministry literature in numerous local languages have been distributed. This has helped to gain many seekers who have formed the nucleus of a number of new churches. Books and gospel tracts are currently being distributed in English and six other Indian languages reaching 739 million people. Additionally, books are being translated and prepared in another 7 Indian languages, thus increasing our reach to over 1.1 billion.

In India there are 28 States and 9 Union Territories, and out of these, 12 States and 6 Union Territories have no local churches. These are the current focus of our distribution, especially 5 northern States and 1 Union Territory in the Hindi-speaking heartland. For the spreading of the ministry to these new places, Rhema coordinates closely with Amana Literature. Rhema also coordinates with the churches for the spreading of the ministry in States with existing testimonies. May the churches pray for His move - using the ministry publications as our "cargo" - so the Lord can raise up more golden lampstands in India!



# CHURCHES IN INDIA

The first local church in India was raised up in December of 1988. The Lord has been faithfully moving in the subcontinent of India for more than 30 years. Currently there are 185 churches with over 4400 saints meeting regularly on the Lord's days and over 7000 saints enjoying the Lord in the church life.



## **BRIEF HISTORY:**

From 1978 onward, some saints from Western Canada began to pray for India and started sending ministry books to India. In 1984-85, a brother from the southern part of India read the ministry and began to practice the church life after visiting the churches in North America. The first local church was raised up in Trivandrum, Kerala in 1988. From 1991 onward, a brother from Canada regularly visited the churches in coordination with the local saints. In 1996, another brother from the southern part of India was gained by the Lord and soon 5 other local churches were raised up. Meanwhile, the Indian Gospel Book Room was established in the same year. In 1997, the work in India began and since then hundreds of coworkers along with their families have been sent by the Taiwan Gospel Work. In 2002, the first local church was raised up in the northern part of India. In 2010, FTTND formally began, and hundreds of trainees have passed through the training.

## **1.) FOLLOWING THE MINISTRY:**

All the churches in India are endeavoring to follow the Lord's up-to-date speaking in His recovery by pursuing His speaking in the 7 feasts through video trainings, HWMR and blending conferences and trainings. Ministry books are being translated into various Indian languages for the saints' long-term nourishment. In addition, the Recovery Version of the New Testament in a few of the Indian languages will be made available to the churches in India by 2021.

## **3.) SPREADING OF THE TESTIMONY:**

As most of the churches are situated in south India (~75%), 12 northern and northeastern states of India are still without the Lord's testimony. Through the coordination of Amana Literature and Rhema serving ones with the saints in the churches, many doors are open to the ministry. Please pray that the Lord will soon gain His testimony in these 12 states!

## **2.) BUILDING UP OF LOCAL CHURCHES:**

All the churches in India are endeavoring to practice the church life according to the scriptural way of meeting and service through the God-man living and the practice of the God-ordained way. Saints are encouraged to function and the universal priesthood could thus be recovered among the churches by the perfecting of the saints unto the work of the ministry, unto the building up of the Body of Christ!

## **4.) RAISING UP NEXT GENERATION:**

For the advancement of the Lord's move in India, the churches are also endeavoring to raise up the next generation, namely, children, young people, and college students. Especially through the campus work in the major cities, many young vessels can be gained, and many will answer the Lord's call after graduation to join the FTTND.
