To the churches in the Lord's Recovery,

The mass demonstrations and civil unrests with escalating violence since June this year have plunged Hong Kong into mayhem unprecedented in decades. Hundreds of thousands cannot go to work when the public transport system has been damaged. Several major universities have already ended this year's semester. Many non-local university students have left Hong Kong for fear of personal safety. Over 4,500 protesters have been arrested so far, many are university or secondary school students.

We thank the Lord that amidst the recent chaos in Hong Kong, the saints remain in the church life enjoying Him as the all sufficient grace and supply. We also receive the burden from the Lord to seize this opportunity to preach the gospel to the citizens in Hong Kong. Praise Him that in the past few months, we have already baptized 180 new ones.

We are conscious of the need to rise up to pray steadfastly for His interests and testimony in Hong Kong. We have asked the saints to form prayer groups to have watchful prayers. But we realize that we need the Body in this matter. We beseech the churches in the Lord's Recovery to stand with us and pray for Hong Kong. In particular, we would like to ask you to pray for the following items:

- 1. That the Lord will continue to preserve and strengthen the church in Hong Kong.
- 2. That the church in Hong Kong will continue to pray steadfastly for His interests and move in Hong Kong.
- 3. That there will be no disruptions to the regular church meetings.
- 4. That the gospel will continue to prevail both in the campuses and community.
- 5. That young people will be protected and preserved for His purpose.
- 6. That the Lord will guide the Hong Kong Government to resolve the current crisis appropriately.
