For many years we have been praying to the Lord with a view to acquiring a property in São Paulo, that could serve the church in Sao Paulo and, the work of the Lord in Brazil, and even all of South America.

Recently we found a property with an excellent location and price. It has a four-story building with a total of 1,750 square meters (18,836 square feet) of usable space. The first floor can serve as a meeting hall with the capacity to hold up to five hundred people. The second floor can be used for children's meetings after remodeling. The third and fourth floors can be used for the publication work and other needs of the work. In addition, there is a parking garage in the basement that can park up to 40 cars.

The price of the property including the needed repairs is US\$1,563,600. We currently have around half of this amount, but we are still lacking approximately US\$800,000. A letter to the churches in Brazil was sent out this week and we have been receiving offerings from the churches and saints in Brazil. However, we also feel before the Lord to open this need to the fellowship of the universal body of Christ.
