Italy (Milan)

February 3

After coordination, we separated into two teams to go to Politecnico di Milano-Bovisa and Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca to preach the gospel. We had very positive and in-depth conversations with many students, and many exchanged their numbers with us for further contact. Some of us also had appointments with the ones we met these past couple of days. We thank the Lord for all these open ones and pray that the Lord would continue to arrange these appointments. In the evening, we had some strong prayer in the prayer meeting of the church.

February 4

Because of the rainy weather, we didn't table outside. Instead, we broke into twos and threes to personally contact students on the two campuses and a shopping mall. We've found that the college students here at large are polite, friendly, and willing to converse with us. We've been learning to reach these students not as "evangelists preaching the gospel" but just as "visitors in the area looking to make friends and share what we believe." The Lord seems to be blessing this way; although we do not come away with mass numbers of tracts passed out, we are able to consistently have substantial conversations and genuine human connections. We are beginning to have second and third appointments.

In the evening, some of us attended home meetings while others had a welcome dinner with the gospel contacts. Four new ones attended the dinner, and all of them were open for further contact with us. While we were fellowshiping with one another on the metro ride back, we noticed a young woman listening to us. We ended up talking to her for the rest of the ride. Although she was not saved, she was intently listening to us as we shared with her about Christ as the Author of our faith. At the end, she gave us her contact and we hope to have an appointment with her this coming Saturday. Our gospel time has not been limited to the dedicated time on the campuses, but we are truly experiencing that when we are enjoying the Lord and filled with the Spirit, everyone is a gospel contact and every time is gospel time.



February 5

After coordination this morning, we split off to visit both Università degli Studi di Milano-Bicocca and Politecnico di Milano Bovisa and have appointments. Today we had our fourth appointment with a PhD student. He attended the welcome dinner last night and is looking forward to our next gathering. May this one be remaining fruit for the church. After the gospel preaching time, some of us had lunch at a restaurant owned by the parents of a gospel contact that we met several days ago. We were able to talk to both of her parents and get to know her more in a human way. May the Lord gain this household for His purpose.

After lunch we went on a tour around Duomo (a landmark of Milan). In a plaza where lots of tourists were, we sang two hymns in different languages (English, Italian, and Spanish). We really enjoyed the Lord and released our spirit by singing, and many were attracted to stop to listen and took videos of us.

In the evening we had a sweet blending time with the local saints. One of the new ones received the Lord in our fellowship after dinner.
