February 6

After coordination, some of us went to the campuses to table and contact the students, while others had appointments with the open ones that we met these past few days. Some of us spent more than four hours with two local Italian students that we met this week. During our lunch together they were wide open. As we talked, they asked some very good questions, and we got to share with them about the life-giving Spirit, God's economy, and the divine romance. After lunch, they showed us around the city and invited us for coffee and dessert in the evening. By spending such a substantial time with them, we got to know them more in a personal way. Praise the Lord for their openness! We were able to connect them with a local sister and we hope that they would be open for meals at her house in the near future. In the evening, some had dinner appointments with the new contacts, while some joined the orientation meeting with the next set of gospel teams (Olympic Games 1, OL1) arriving tonight.



February 7

Today we spread to three malls for the gospel. Unlike the previous days, we had both local saints and OL1 saints joining us. Some were led to pray to receive the Lord. Since our groups had a mix of saints from the OL1 and TR5 (Torch Relay 5) trips, the saints on the OL1 trip were able to benefit from the

learnings of the saints on TR5 team this past week. The TR5 saints were encouraged by the exercise of the OL1 saints. In the evening, we had a gospel dinner at a local restaurant and five new ones attended. The new ones really enjoyed the time and we were all cherished and encouraged. At the end, a brother spoke to encourage us all, sharing that our gathering with the believers is the way to continue to receive spiritual supply. On the way back, we continued to have good fellowship with two of the new ones. Another two contacts promised to come again to our love feast on Lord's Day.



February 8

During the love feast, one prayed to receive the Lord. After the meeting, some had appointments with the new ones. One student whom we met this Monday and have been meeting every day throughout this week pray-read a verse with a brother during their appointment. He prayed, "Lord, thank You for serving me so that I can serve You." Praise the Lord for this one! We marveled at the Lord's work in him.

In the evening, we had an overflow meeting with all the saints in TR5. All the teams (Padua, Rome, Turin, and Lugano, Switzerland) shared their enjoyment and experience in their gospel outreach this past week. It was really glorious! After the overflow meeting, some saints had dinner together and we bid farewell to one another. This concluded our gospel trip.
